**REQUIREMENTS FOR RIDERS:** Open to riders between the ages of 9 and 109. All participants must ride in English tack.

Riders must be able to control their mounts safely and competently at a canter, with experience schooling over 18" or higher courses - Green Level and above. Riders will choose their fence heights (from 18" to 3'6") for clinic and



competition.

**REQUIREMENTS FOR HORSES:** Mounts should be sound and fit enough for two hours of strenuous work per day. Copy of your current negative Coggins and visual health check required upon arrival. We *may* have a few mounts available to lease for the clinic on a first-come-first-served basis.

**FEES:** \$85 for both days, incl. Show Jump Competition. (\$75 for our current students.)

**PARENTS:** Parents are welcome to audit the clinic at no charge.

**DIRECTIONS:** We're about an hour north of Atlanta off of Interstate 575 and an hour east of Rome off of Hwy 53. Map and detailed directions are available on our website: [www.eaglemountainstables.com](http://www.eaglemountainstables.com). For MapQuest or similar directions, our street address is *27 Eagle Mountain Drive, Ellijay*. But please, don't send entry forms to this address!

**ATTIRE:** We're gonna get dirty, so save your nice, new show clothes for Sunday's show! Sturdy riding tights or jodhpurs will be most comfortable; stretchy riding jeans are fine. Paddock boots (or similar boots) and ASTM-SEI helmets are required. We will have a limited number of helmets available to borrow.

**STABLING:** We occasionally have a few stalls available for overnight boarding at \$10/per night; we also have two paddocks for horses that can stay overnight in a pasture, at no charge. Call or email us to discuss options.

**OVERNIGHT ACCOMODATIONS:** The Stables is adjacent to a huge resort community with a zillion rental cabins. There are also two hotels nearby. Call or email us for more information.



**MEALS:** We recommend bringing a bagged lunch; we have a fridge and microwave in the lounge for re-heatable meals. The usual fast food options are within 10 miles.

**DOGS:** All dogs must be leashed at all times. Chronic barkers or cat-chasers should be left at home, please.

#### **DON'T FORGET TO BRING:**

- layered clothing appropriate for changes in weather
- sunscreen
- folding chairs/cameras for the tournament
- bagged lunch or lunch money
- snacks/plenty of water/juice
- enthusiasm, sunny natures and helpful hands!
